







## Call for short Papers for the Joint Conference on: Narratives in times of radical transformations Interdisciplinary Perspectives

We would be pleased to receive abstracts for short papers. The short papers are limited to seven minute each and should not include more than five power point slides. The abstracts should not exceed one page and include the title of the presentation, the name and addresses of the authors, the name and e-mail address of the corresponding author, the name of the session in which short presentation should be displayed and a short description of the main propositions and results for what the paper will include.

Please note that the deadline for the submission of proposals for short papers is the <u>1<sup>st</sup> of September</u> <u>2020.</u> Please, also note that should your proposal be accepted no honorariums or expenses can be paid to presenters. Submission of a proposal will be understood to indicate a willingness to attend the entire Conference.

The program committee will review the abstracts and inform you about acceptance before Sept. 30. Once your paper has been accepted you need to register for the conference before September 30.

All participants who had already submitted abstracts for posters are automatically transferred to short paper presentations. Due to the video format, a poster presentation will not be feasible.
